Report Title: Garbage and Recycling Collection

Recommended Resolution:

Item #1:

That the correspondence from Circular Materials Ontario (CMO) be received and that the following recommendations be adopted:

That Council direct staff to prepare and release a Request for Tender to be issued this fall for garbage curbside collection starting January 1, 2026, with the following options:

- a) Weekly pickup;
- b) Bi-weekly garbage pickup;
- c) Curbside collection at the locations of: Musky Island Road and South of Markstay (optional).
- d) Alternate / additional recycling collection at the landfill to receive recycling from businesses and residents, this will promote diversion of recyclable materials generated from campgrounds and commercial businesses from the landfill.

Item #2:

Staff to enter into an Agreement with E360 Environmental Solutions for weekly garbage collection services for residents of St.-Charles that are located South of Markstay (14 households) with the following option:

- a) With an end date of December 31, 2025 (recommended pending outcome of garbage collection tender);
- b) With an end date that would coincide with the Markstay-Warren Contract with E360 Environmental Solutions (most likely stable and lower cost).



Analysis & Background:

Item #1:

We have received confirmation from Circular Materials Ontario that Waste Management (WM) of Canada Corp. will be the provider of recycling collection services for the Municipality as of January 1, 2026 (and also French River as of Spring 2025).

During discussions with WM Canada, the following recommendations were made to the Municipality:

- Because of the major shift in providers and the current 2-year delay in procuring new garbage trucks, the Municipality would potentially avoid delay by tendering the curbside **garbage** collection this fall.
- WM Canada is required to maintain current weekly curbside recycling pick-up and there would be opportunity for cost savings if services were combined.
- Further (mutual) savings could be explored if by-weekly pick up is considered, it would relieve WM of the mandated weekly pick of recycling (Could consider everyone gets 2 free bags per week drop off at landfill)
- Starting January 1, 2026, the Municipality would no longer be eligible for the +/- \$20k grant for picking up recycling. (all costs associated with recycling pickup are then borne to the producer).
- Recycling bin at landfill site. Because we are not collecting recycling at the landfill, this service is not a required service for WM to provide. If we were to request a bin at the landfill it would have to be mutually agreed by us, WM Canada and CMO. The WM representative seems to believe it would be possible, but it may be at a cost to us for businesses recycling portion.
